The mission of the BC/VOAD Long Term Recovery Committee is to identify, assess, facilitate and provide resources to help meet the unmet needs of survivors impacted by Hurricane Sandy in Bergen County, New Jersey.

Bergen-Achievements to Date - 4/14

- Fully furnished high-tech Recovery Info Center (First Presbyterian Church, Moonachie)
- 11 full-time paid staff/1 full time VISTA
- 940 intakes 646 assigned to case manager
- \$1.5 million allocated to rebuild/restore
- 181 mobile homes' undersides re-insulated
- 283 homes repaired + 255 additional mold remediated
- 44 "Field Contact" volunteers augment staff
- 6,400 volunteers mobilized in relief/response
- 53,381 hours of volunteer time


